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## **Deus Brut des Flandres** *(Belgium & France) 750ml bottle*

Truly the Dom Perignon of beers, it is enjoyed like champagne. As smooth as silk, blossoming into a creamy, tingling sparkle with hints of citrus, ginger and malts. 45

## **Hennepin Farmhouse Saison** *(New York)*

Brewed to refresh the workers as they come off the Belgium fields, it's golden in color and effervescent, with hints of spicy gingersnap and citrusy hops. 6

## **Duvel** *(Belgium)*

A Belgium classic, it has a billowy white head, rich creaminess and light lemony, hoppy crispness. 8

## **Young's Oatmeal Stout** *(England)*

16.9 ounces of a stout lovers dream! Creamy darkness with a hint of toasted bread at the finish, but none of the bitterness of Irish stouts. 8

## **Tilburg's Dutch Brown Ale** *(Netherlands)*

A toasty dark and slightly sweet ale that has great caramelized tones 5

## **Carlsberg Elephant** *(Copenhagen)*

Named after the elephant gate entrance to the brewery. A 7.2% malt liquor with a smooth & distinctive taste. 5

## **Hacker-Pschorr Weisse** *(Germany)*

A perfect example of what a German unfiltered wheat beer should be. 5
